

**INTO ME SEE – PART 2  
KNOWN TO KNOW HIM  
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**I. HE INTIMATELY KNOWS YOU**

- Principally all humans desire **intimacy**.
- Psalm 139:1–3, “... searched... know... understand...intimately acquainted...”
- **Intimately** - to be of use, service, profit
- This is God telling us **He** is **useful** to us.
- Psalm 139:4-6, “O LORD, You know it all...”
- You were made **like** Him and He **knows** your ways.
- **Enclosed** - to confine, secure, form, and fashion
- Romans 8:28-30, “... conformed to the image of His Son... called...justified... glorified.”
- Jesus was always in **connection** with the Father.
- Psalms 19:7, “...The testimony of the Lord is sure making wise the simple.”
- Establish all your decisions in the **Word**.
- God handled **rejection** by never losing sight of His **purpose**.
- **Called** - to call aloud, utter in a loud voice
- **Justified** - to make righteous, to display, show or exhibit righteousness
- **Glorified** - To cause the dignity and worth of Christ to be manifested and acknowledged.

**II. GETTING TO KNOW HIM**

- If we are going to be **intimate** with God, we must learn His **ways**.
- God took Moses from fear and failure to faith and freedom through **intimacy**.
- 1. Moses asks for Intimate **knowledge** of God.
- Exodus 33:13, “... let me know Your ways that I may know You...”
- 2. Moses asks for permanent **access**.
- Exodus 33:15 “If Your presence does not go with us, do not lead us up from here.
- Moses understood that His **presence** proved His **favor** and His **identity**.
- 3. Moses asks for **authority**.
- Exodus 33:18, “I pray You, show me Your glory!”
- **Glory** - honor, reputation, splendor
- Moses asked for God’s **authority**.

**III. GOD ON GOD**

- Exodus 34:5-7, “The LORD, the LORD God, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth...”
- Moses understood intimacy required **worship**.
- Exodus 34:8, “Moses made haste to bow low toward the earth and worship.”
